Hilary Gilbert, Jr. was born June 8, 1924. He has been a member of the Ocean View Baptist Church since 1931, having joined the church at seven years of age. He was active in all the organizations of the church.

Ho attended the Ocean View Elementary School

and the Granby High School.

He entered the service February 11, 1943, having been inducted at Camp Loe. He received his training at Camp Crowder, No., Seymour-Johnson Airfield, and after having spent sometime in California was sent overseas in October 1943.

He wont directly to the South Pacific with his first station at New Caledonia. After covering several Islands, he entered the Admiralty Islands, his last base. He completed twenty-two missions

serving as an Aerial Photographer.

He was reported missing August 10, 1944 and the Army has set March 12, 1946 as the presumptive date of death.
