Received the package you sent yesterday, & went to thank you for it. Everything came all right except the box of chocolate. I don't know what it was, but it looks like it was all melted together & then hardened again.

We didn't do very much yesterday, because the schedule at the field was the same as for every other day. We had breakfast at home & came to the field at 11 o'clock for ground school. However, we found that the schedule was all balled up as usual, & went home again at 12. We took Don & Sid with us, & when we got home, we all went to the lake near our house to take pictures. Then we had dinner about 3:30 & came back to the field at 5 to fly. We didn't fly, however, & went home after hanging around until 10 P.M. The girls went to the movies in the evening, but were home when we got home.

Today we had to be in at 11 A.M. to fly in the afternoon. We took off at 3, but were called back

about 4:45 because the weather was closing in. There
was plenty of weather up there today, & they expect
snow here tonight. I'm at the club now waiting for

are grounded because of them.

As it is, even though we don't do much at the field,
our time is wasted for us, & we have to be here at
some time every day.
