Things are finally beginning to happen down here. I started my exams on Wednesday & expect to complete them tomorrow. On Wednesday, we took written psychological aptitude tests which took about 8 hours. On Thursday, we took psychological coordination tests, which are tests on various types of machines & apparatus designed to test muscular coordination, speed of reaction & ability to follow instructions. Today, we had the first part of the physical, which consisted of X-ray, vaccination, blood test, urine analysis, & interview with psychiatrist. Tomorrow, we will have the rest of our physical & probably on Sunday, we will get our first set of injections.

The weather down here has been pretty good all week up to today. Yesterday, it was like summer, but today, it has been pouring on & off all day long.
