Now, it's Sunday, & I'll try to finish the letter. Last night, Pearl came to the field, & we had dinner at the officers' club. We hung around for a little while, & then went back to town. There's a dance every Saturday at the club, but we didn't stay last night, because I had to get up early this morning.

I didn't get any of the packages you sent, but I guess they'll come within the next few days. Thanks for all of them, but it wasn't necessary. Tell Grandma that I don't need anything, & she should save her money.

The reason that Pearl wasn't over to Grandma before she left, was that she didn't know exactly when she was leaving until Wednesday at noon time.

The railroad called her Wednesday at noon & confirmed reservations for Wednesday afternoon. She thought that she was going to leave on Thursday. If her father hadn't helped with the reservations, she would have had to wait about 4 weeks.
