Beah is fine, & has been busy up to now, looking for an apartment. She finally found one yesterday, & was very happy about it. We're taking it with another couple, so the girls won't have to be alone when we have to fly at night. The woman

she rented it from is furnishing us with everything including linens, towels, blankets, & even dishes & silverware. I think we are going to move in tomorrow.
