Just came home from the base after a very hard day. I left here this morning about 7:30 & got to the base about 8. Had breakfast & went to the barracks & lay down & read. Had lunch at 12:30, & played football for an hour from 1:30 to 2:30. Then took a shower, shave, & washed my hair, got dressed & came home. However, we're scheduled to fly tomorrow morning, so we have to sleep at the base & get up at 5 A.M. & get down to the flight line by 5:45. So far, I've flown only 3 times, but one of these days, we'll begin to fly. When we do fly, though, we fly in every direction but west, because the mountains are there.

I know that Pearl wrote you the other day & told you all about the Thanksgiving dinner we had, so I don't have to go over that again. It was very good, though, & everyone enjoyed it. Pearl really enjoys cooking & keeping house.

Received your letter the other day, but as yet, have not received the package. I'll probably get it any day now. Forget about the woolen socks because I don't need them. I have plenty.

Am enclosing a picture of our crew that was taken the other day. Reading from left to right on top is the pilot, co-pilot, navigator & bombardier. Below are the engineer, assistant engineer, radio man, & gunner.
