It's Monday morning now, & I'm home, so I decided to write to you.

We had a pretty big day yesterday. I got through at the Base at 11 in the morning, so we went up to Colorado Springs. We took the bus from here at about 1 o'clock, & got there in an hour. We went to the Broadmoor Hotel, which is famous throughout the country & really something to see. It's a city in itself, & they charge \$25 a day per person just for the room during their season. Now, it only costs \$15 a day. We had lunch there, & then got a cab & went sightseeing. There's so much to see around there that you need at least a week to see it all. We had time to go only to the Valley of the Gods & the Cave of the Winds. The country is really something to see, & we took movies & snapshots of it. We had dinner up

there, & took a train back about 9 o'clock,  
getting home at 10.

This morning, I was supposed to be at  
the base at 8, but when I got there, I found  
that the schedule was changed, & I had nothing  
to do until 4 in the afternoon, so I came home  
again.

heard a program from Washington, where the weather  
is freezing today. We had a little snow the other  
day, & the weather went down to zero, but  
you don't feel it much here.
