Dear Mom & Drey,

I received two letters from Drey during the past week, & the second page of a V-mail letter from you. That came five days ago, but I still haven't gotten the first page.

I really meant to write to you during the week, but I've been pretty busy. We flew every day during the week, & yesterday we flew twice. We got up at three in the morning to fly a long navigation flight, which took nine hours. When we came back, we heard that we were supposed to fly again from nine at night until three in the morning. However, we finally flew

from midnight to three. Now, to-
night, we have another mission
from midnight until ten tomorrow
morning. In addition, they had
ground school classes scheduled
for yesterday afternoon, & this
afternoon. We didn't go yesterday,
& then made them cancel the
classes for today. We will prob-
ably be assigned to a squadron,
& get out of here within the next
couple of days, & then, we will
have only to fly a few days
each week to rest.

How have you been? Dney
wrote that you had a sore throat,
but that it didn't interfere much
with your voice. She also com-
plained about all the work she
had to do on her day off. I
guess she still likes her sleep, as

she always did.

The food is still good, & I don't think that I've lost very much of the weight that I put on in Pueblo. I still have plenty of weight, & would like to lose some of it. I guess I will, too.

will write to you as often as I can, & will expect to hear from all of you. Remember me to Ail & Al, & Grandpa & Grandma.
