since it is our only form of recreation here. Most
of the pictures are not first run, many of them the
better pictures of two & three years ago. For instance,
since I've been on this island, they've had "Casablanca",
"The More the Merrier", "Lady in a Jam", "Design for Scandal"
last night with Walter Pidgeon, Rosalind Russell, & Edward
Arnold. Further down the line, they have newer pictures,
but they take time to get up here.

Hope you got my flowers today. Let me
know, as I ordered them some time ago, & want to
be sure you got them. Hope that we can all spend
this day next year together.

Remember me to everyone at home, & let
me hear from all of you very soon.
