Thank you for your request. We have attached copies of the record cards for the two B-24Ds, s/ns 41-24012 and 41-24065. According to the records, the B-24D, s/n 41-24012, was received on 4 Oct 1942 and assigned to Salina AAF KS on 22 Dec 1942. It departed the US for the Seventh Air Force, Pacific Theater of Operations, on 1 Jan 1943. It remained in the Pacific until it was disposed as salvage on 23 Jun 1945. The B-24D, s/n 41-24065, was received on 16 Oct 1942 and assigned to Biggs AAF TX on 30 Jan 1943. It was assigned to Pueblo AAF CO on 25 May 1943 on was dropped from inventory due to a flying accident on 4 Dec 1943.
