Edeut. SFENGLER was leading the torpedo planes and targets of opportunity were assigned in the area of the term of Yap. The pilots circled for some time picking out specific targets and then made individual runs. Sees of them made several runs trying to make every bomb do the most destruction. Several A/A implacements were hit and damaged. Two buildings in the barracks area were destroyed and four others damaged. Several fires were started and one plane dropped on the causeway where it connects with the town of Yap, damaging it. A total of thirteen thousand five hundred lbs. of bombs were dropped and two photographic sorties were made.

One pilot dropped a life raft to a downed dive bomber pilot which alded considerable in the eventual rescue by a "Eingrisher."

After the attack all planes rendegvoused south of the island and then returned to Your where they were landed aboard by 0945.
