

Information received by this Command indicates that Special Maritime Group #1 participated in Underwater Demolition work in connection with landings on Angaur Island, Palau, 12 September to 18 September 1944; Ulithi Islands, 22 September to 25 September 1944; Leyte Island, P.I., 18 October to 22 October 1944, with the resulting loss of two members of the group.
